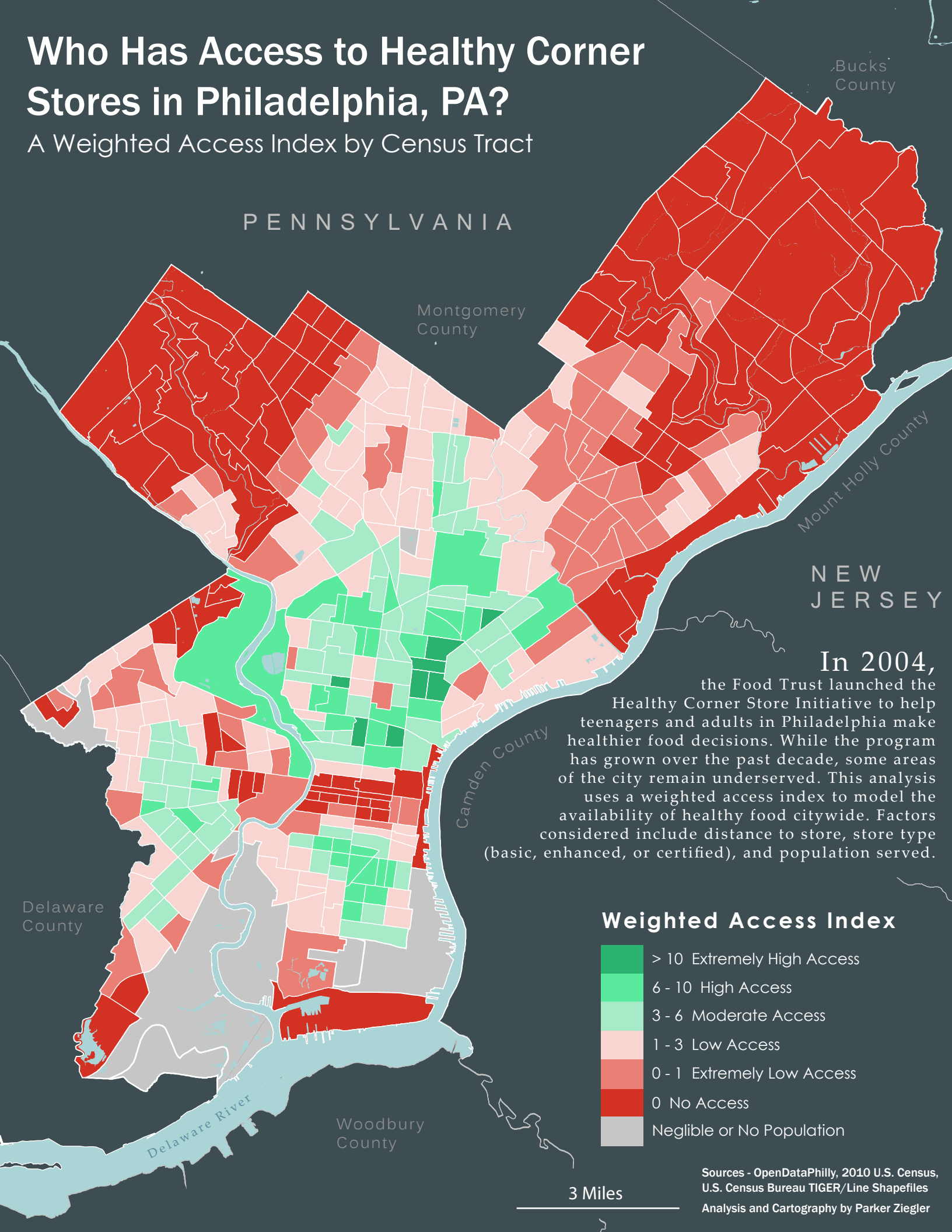


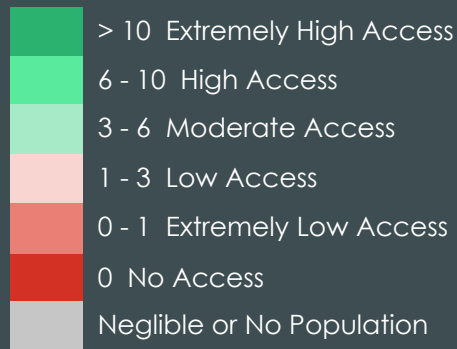
# Who Has Access to Healthy Corner Stores in Philadelphia, PA?

A Weighted Access Index by Census Tract



In 2004, the Food Trust launched the Healthy Corner Store Initiative to help teenagers and adults in Philadelphia make healthier food decisions. While the program has grown over the past decade, some areas of the city remain underserved. This analysis uses a weighted access index to model the availability of healthy food citywide. Factors considered include distance to store, store type (basic, enhanced, or certified), and population served.
